## Celebrate Cape Coral event to feature Nashville performer Randolph

Ken Randolph, a Nashville recording artist, will be the musical headliner at the TIB Bank Celebrate Cape Coral on Saturday, March 7, in Big John's Plaza, Southeast 47th Terrace, Cape Coral.
